## Deadly Trials

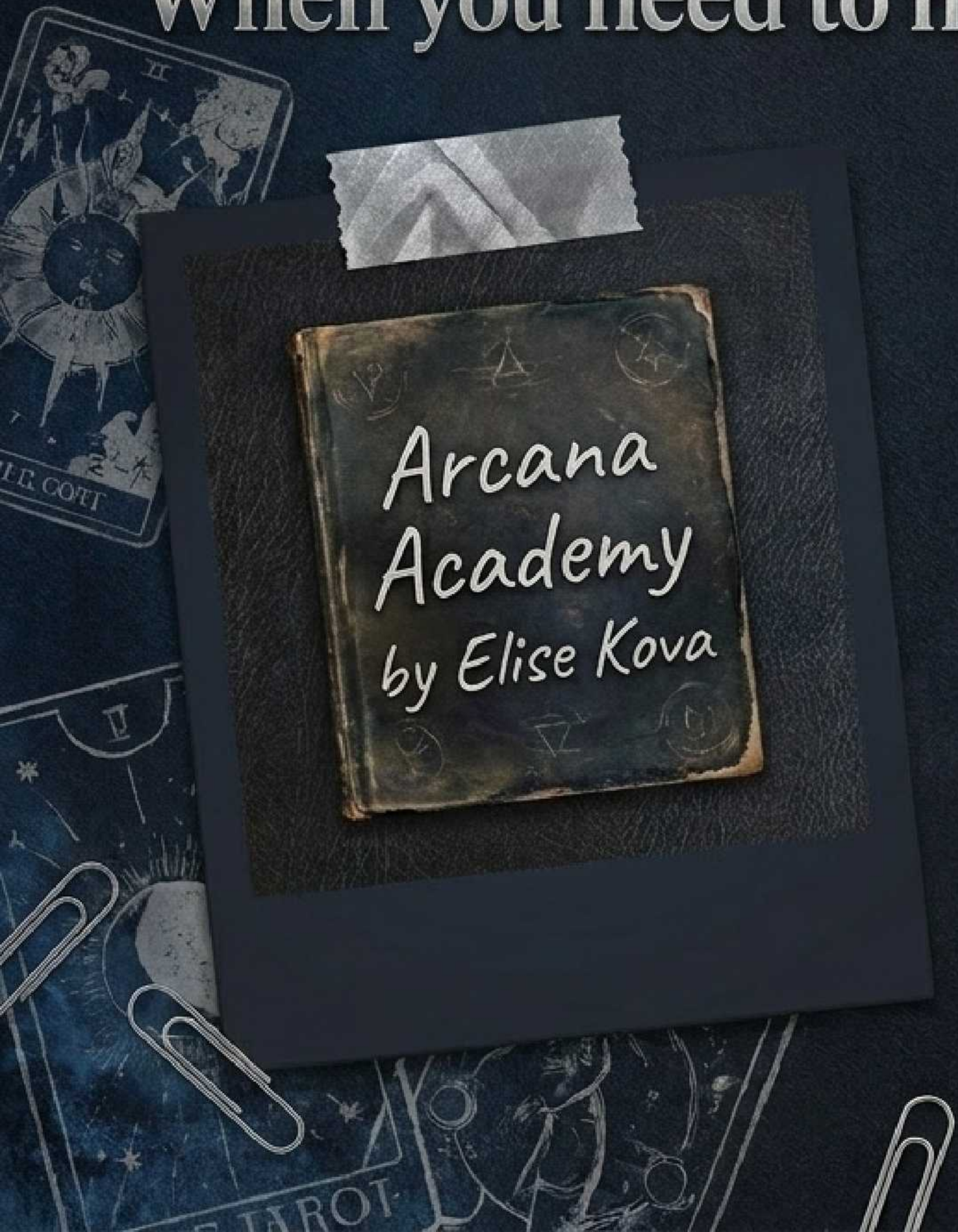
